Hospitals and medical facilities rely on freshly sanitised and hygienic linen to use within their facilities to prevent the spread of disease.

On pick up, hospital laundry trucks carry linen, which contain bacteria and body fluids many of which can be hazardous to those who come in contact with it. Even worse, bacteria can harbour in unsealed areas within the vehicle causing further issues when transporting freshly sanitised linen back to the medical facility.



RhinoGuard 2195 spray applied Hybrid Polyurethane was specified for these hospital laundry vehicles due to the products total sealing and encapsulating capabilities.

The fibreglass ply wall corners and chequer plate floor were totally sealed at the joints and aluminium oxide grit was added to prevent slippage. This has allowed the truck to be hosed out regularly to control hygiene and provide a safe work place for the people loading the linen trolleys in what is often a wet environment.
